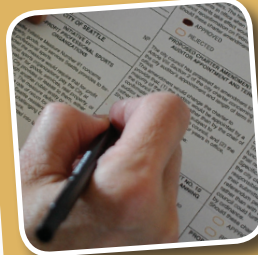
1 IDENTIFICATION
